86. BLACK SCIENTISTS AND INVENTORS

We thank you, O God, for the scientific ingenuity of African Americans, which has often gone unrecognized in the histories of the world. We have discovered that black men and women are among the world's greatest inventors.

Benjamin Banneker was a self-taught mathematician and astronomer who received international recognition for his almanacs. He also designed the layout of Washington, D.C., our nation's capital.

We are inventors. George Washington Carver suffered through slavery and childhood illness to later fashion an abundance of products from the peanut and sweet potato. Black inventors have improved the quality of life for all Americans. Labor-saving devices and other inventions have helped both our agricultural and urban centers. These range from the elevator to the fire extinguisher, from the traffic signal to the pencil sharpener.

M.C. Harney, L.S. Buridge, N.R. Marshman, W.B. Purvis, H. Blair and G.E. Beckett gave this country the lamp, the typewriter, the fountain pen, the corn harvester and the mail box.

O God, you are the Maker of miracles. We celebrate black inventions that have made our lives better.

We are doctors. Dr. Charles R. Drew helped make blood banks possible by determining that plasma can be preserved and stored for later use. Dr. T. K. Lawless discovered cures for many skin diseases.

We are scientists. Ernest Everett Just was a leader in microbiology, researching the cell, the embryo and the fertilization process at Howard University.

Black scientists and inventors have served as God's hands on earth. Now, O God, may we work with diligence, utilizing our talents to bring to fruition the future you have already promised us.
