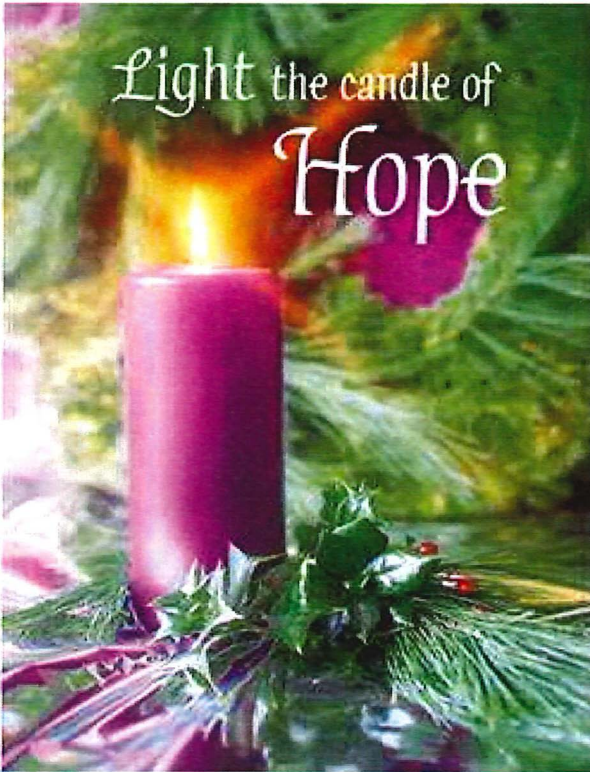

Bishop Stanley Maurice Butler

Bishop Stanley M. Butler is a no-nonsense, "old-world gentleman" in the Gospel. He is serious about the business to which he has been called and less than patient with anyone who takes the call of God and the work of God lightly.

Putting Traditionalism aside, Bishop Butler found no fulfillment until he began his upstream movement in establishing Sanctuary in 1991. No denominations, No pews, No steeples, Not many people. However the Vision was sure, and Bishop Butler knows he was sent to the inner city where people were having their dreams dashed by the hopelessness of poverty, the helplessness of illiteracy and the havoc of crime and substance abuse. This was the place he had to be.

At the same time, Sanctuary church was established: he began a ministry to homeless men, a program of transitional housing called Temple House. The now legendary ministry has had an impact on the lives of more than 500 men, men who have mended fences and returned to their families, men who have found gifts and talents—men who have a new image of themselves as entrepreneurs, teachers and preachers, many of whom have become mentors to others. They all came transitioned through Temple House.

As Senior Pastor of Sanctuary Church, Bishop Butler stepped back so another could put on the mantle of this house. However, anyone who knows him knew Bishop Butler was not under the illusion that ministry was over for him. It would only be a short time before the dreams would begin again. Bishop Butler was moving on to a new thing, the birth of Market-Place Fellowship & Churches, Inc. Since the conception of this "work", numerous Pastors and Ministries have come under the covering of Bishop Stanley Butler as they work collectively to do business for Jesus.

Bishop Stanley M. Butler has been married to Lady Glenda Butler for more than 25 years. He is the father to four, grandfather to eight and his spiritual children are innumerable.

Announcement
