Rev. Dr. April Rhinehardt is a Christian who has been called by God to preach, teach, challenge and train others for the kingdom building work of God. Her ministry has been transformed and enhanced as she works as a collaborator and calm presence in crisis situations. Dr. Rhinehardt is a Board-Certified Chaplain, a Certified Life Coach, and a Suicide Intervention Specialist.

Presently, Dr. Rhinehardt is a Hospice Chaplain serving those patients and their families who have been given a terminal diagnosis. She has also served as the Dean of the Chapel at Shaw University, a Chaplain at Wake Forest Baptist (Atrium) Medical Center, a Chaplain at High Point Regional Medical Center and as a School Counselor for Guilford County Schools.

Educationally, she holds a Doctor of Ministry in Leadership Development from Regent University, a Master of Divinity from Shaw University, a Masters of Counseling from North Carolina A&T State University and a Bachelors of Arts in Psychology from UNC Charlotte. Rev. Rhinehardt was ordained through the Rowan Baptist Association and she coordinates the program for endorsing Chaplains for Board Certification with the General Baptist State Convention. She holds membership with the Association of Professional Chaplains and the North Carolina Chaplains Association. Dr. Rhinehardt did contribute in a published article “Accepting Transitions: African Americans Discuss End of Life” in the American Journal of Hospice and Palliative Care.

Personally, Dr. Rhinehardt is most proud of the fact that she is the mother of two adult children. John Rhinehardt Jr. and Dr. Kristen Rhinehardt. She has a daughter-in law, Nicole Rhinehardt and three adorable granddaughters, Kai, Khloe and Kennedy Rhinehardt. **Dr. Rhinehardt believes that ministry begins at home when your family can follow your footprints as their values and self-worth are developed.**
