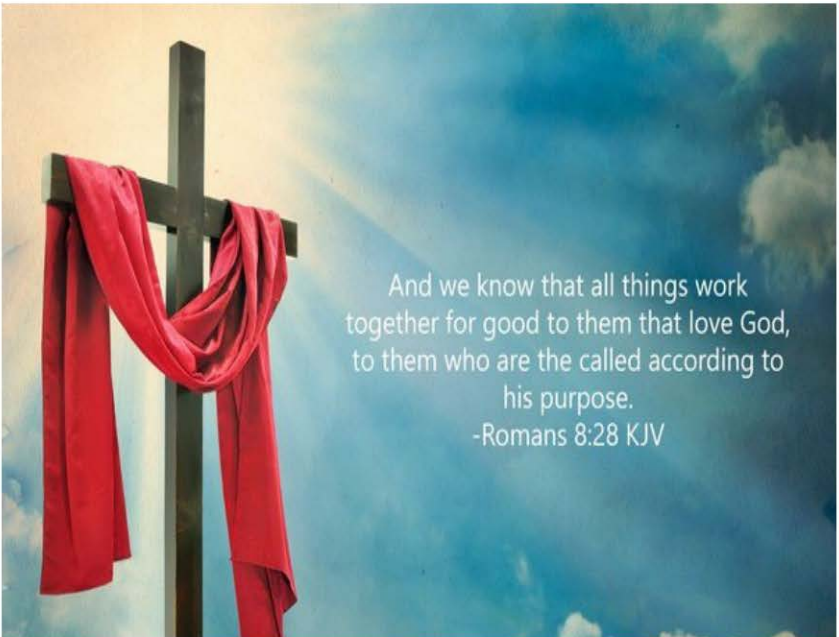

REVEREND MICHAEL ALLEN MCCLAIN is a native of Statesville, North Carolina. He was raised by the McWhirter Family of Georgia, which included his great-grandmother, grandmother, great aunts and a great uncle. At a young age he was baptized and became a member of the Scotts Chapel United Methodist Church. When called into the ministry in 1973 he became the spiritual son of the late Dr. J.C. Harris and a member First Baptist Church of Statesville, North Carolina.

Reverend McClain was educated in the Statesville Public School System. He was ordained in 1974 at the age of twenty by the Rowan Baptist Association at the request of Gethsemane Baptist Church of Salisbury, North Carolina. His education includes Livingston College – Bachelor of Religion and Hood Theological Seminary - Bachelor of Theology (Salisbury, NC) in which he was the youngest student ever admitted. He attended Shaw University (Raleigh, NC) majoring in Public Administration.

Reverend McClain has served churches in NC, NJ and SC. In addition to his ministerial service, Reverend McClain serves in the following Local, State and National Positions: • Media/Public Relations Ministry – Baptist Educational and Missionary Convention of South Carolina • Legislative Affairs Representative – Baptist Educational and Missionary Convention of SC • Executive Board Member – Baptist Educational and Missionary Convention of SC • South Carolina State Conference NAACP Advisory Board Member • Deputy Director General – National Baptist Congress of Christian Education of the National Baptist Convention USA, Inc. Creative Justice Ministries Board of Directors - Washington, DC

He is employed by the National Religious Partnership for the Environment as the National Outreach Coordinator working on Environmental Justice education and advocacy based in Washington, DC, where he works with denominational leaders and congregations across American to educate them on environmental stewardship, climate change, and clean energy. He conducts local, state and national workshops on creation care, health and economic hardships that climate change and legislation have and will have on people of color and marginalized communities.

In July 2019 Rev. McClain took leave from NRPE and assumed the position of Director for Faith Engagement in South Carolina. After winning the presidential primary in SC he was sent Columbus, OH as the OH State Director for Faith Outreach. In April he assumed the position as National Director for African American Faith Engagement for Biden-Harris 2020 Presidential Campaign based in Philadelphia, PA.

In 2007 to 2014 he was appointed South Eastern Regional Director – Eco Justice Organization for the National Council of Churches of Christ USA. The NCC is the largest ecumenical body in the United States representing 38 Christian faith groups and over 100,000 locals' congregations. Working on education and advocacy within the African American denominations across America.

He is founded and is president of Green Bulb Lighting, LLC of Columbia, SC a green energy and lighting efficiency company that specializes in "green technology" installations, including commercial grade solar farm development projects.

Reverend McClain is married to the former Dr. Detra Henry McClain of Winnsboro, SC. They are the parents to Christopher, Nicole, Rosalinda, Courtney. They are the proud grandparents to 8 grand children.
