Do you want to be better?

A literal Hebrew translation of "Pharaoh's heart being hardened" in several of the Chapters of Exodus, means to "bear out what was already there." Sociologist today suggests that adversity or crisis bears out one's true character. The recent political seasons in America bore out characteristics of voters that border on shameful racist and discriminatory behavior. Shameful in the sense that some individuals willfully look down on those who are different, think different, and do things differently. But how different are we? We all come from the Adam and Eve. We all come from the same issue of blood. And we all have the same apparent end. In Amos 6, the Lord Himself asks the question of those who were the chosen; "Are you better?" (Verse 2) Is a Christian really better than a non-Christian? Is a white really better than a black? Is an American really better than a Mexican? The answer is no! We are all the same sinner before God. We all need the salvation available through faith in Jesus Christ. We all need forgiveness. We all need love. You may have money. You may have degrees. You may have the big house. You may have a great job. But you are not better. Only by making Jesus the centrality of your life makes you better. 




