Adolf Hitler, during World War II, had an interesting strategy for attaching various European countries: he attacked routinely on the weekend. Hitler knew that the parliaments of those nations did not have Saturday sessions, making it difficult to react timely to any invasion. In the same way, Satan looks for opportune times to attack our lives. When our guards are down. When things are going well. When we think our children are progressing with their lives. When on the job promotions or salary increases are the norm. What we don't realize is that these things make us weaker and more vulnerable because we feel strong, we feel secured. But strong people don't pray like weak people do. Strong people think about their strengths. Weaker people think about God's strength. Strong people think about what they can do. Weaker people think about what God can do. Selfish promotion of our accomplishments can lead to sin and death. That is what happened to the rich man in Luke 12:16-21. The same thing happened to Herod the king in Acts 12:20-23 Flee temptation and don't leave a forwarding address. Satan is always ready to attack. But God is always ready to save. Be encouraged.
