Two words are critical to our faith in God and our faith in each other. Those words are "name" and "word". The Lord's name is everything to every Christian who follows in the way of Jesus Christ. (Romans 9:17) The Lord's Word is the foundation of our very faith. (Psalm 119:105) To be called a Christian is to claim yourself as a witness for the Word of God. 
