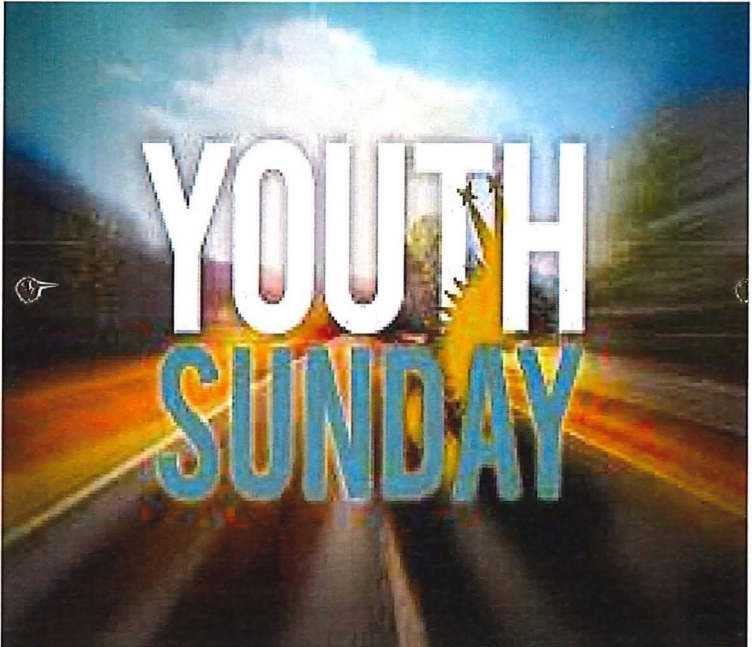

Imagine going to a nice restaurant for dinner. The table is set with linens, fine china, and crystal glasses. The waiter delivers your plate with a flourish. Instead of being believers with a meaty message of hope, we give the world nothing but a single marshmallow of evangelism and discipleship. The Lord wants our encounters with people to be impacted leaving them hopeful and different than before we arrived.
