*It is hard to wait:*

A few years ago Dr. Freddie Haynes III, the visionary pastor of the Friendship-West Church in Dallas preached a sermon entitled, "Waiting can get on your nerves". The heart of the sermon centered on the many life situations that have proven to be unfair and unjust. A father or mother who did not love you. A son or daughter that will not stay out of trouble. A reduction in staff on your job leads to you being the one chosen for layoff rather than the other person who has produced less than you. A spouse who has chosen to leave you for someone else rather than to stay and work your differences out. You spend your career preparing for a supervisory role that was given to a less qualified individual. You wait for a change but the wait gets on your nerves. The expectation for a brighter day grows dim as the wait grows from hours to days to months then into years. It is out of your control. What are you to do? Where is God? The Prophet Zephaniah reminded the chosen people of God that He was in their midst. (Zephaniah 3:17) They were in trouble. They had been disobedient. They had not served the Lord. But the Lord had been there since the beginning. When your day began today God was there. Since He is with you from the beginning stay with Him through the end. That is the promise to those who love Him. (Revelation 2) The crown is at the end. The victory is at the end. To wait is simply to see it through. The closing words of Zephaniah from the Lord is, "I will". Please wait on Him. Be encouraged.

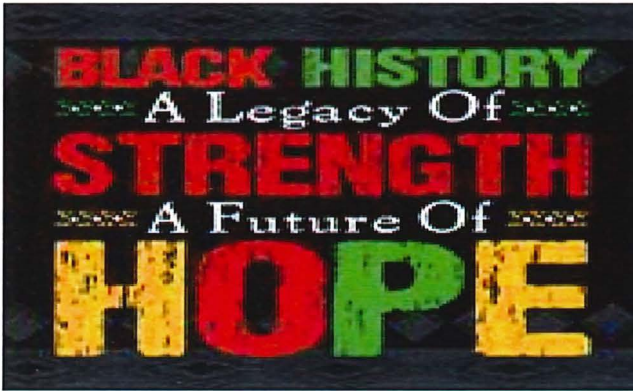
