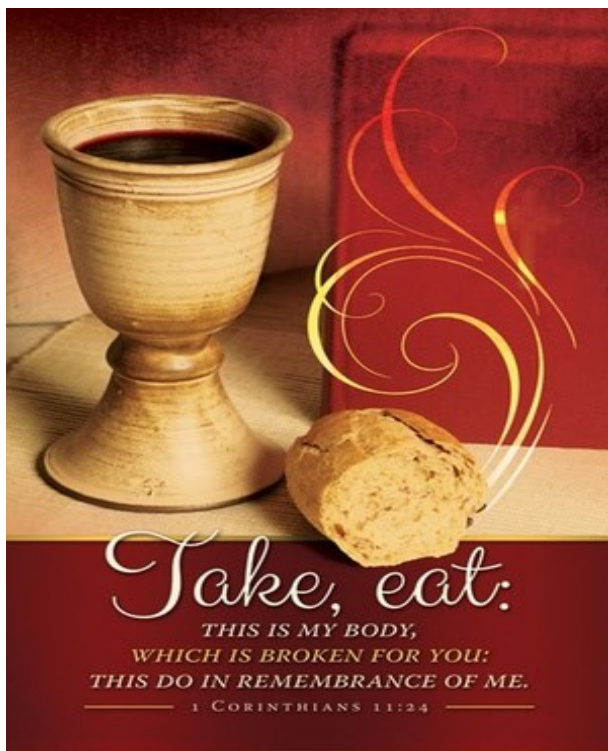

**Devotional**

*Stand as a child of God:*

Everyone faces temptation. Even the son of God was tempted by Satan to turn away from God. But Jesus saw through the enemy's schemes and remained firm in His love and devotion to His Father. (Luke 4:1-13) One of the reasons Jesus came to earth was to personally identify with our needs and struggles. (1 Peter 2:21) He understands how you feel under the weight of temptation. He has faced the tempter and overcome the darkness and adversity associated with Satan's fiery trials. (Matthew 4:1-11) (John 16:33) When you face temptation, know that you do not face it alone. Jesus is with you, and He provides the strength you need to say no to every dark thought or evil imagination that comes your way. (Matthew 28:20) In times of temptation, when the enemy whispers lies to defeat and discourage you, take your stand against him by clothing yourself in the mighty armor of God. (Ephesians 6) Also, know that you can never disappoint God. He knows exactly what you are doing even before you do it, and He loves you still. Temptation is not a sin. Sin is the result of our acting on the temptation. The Lord has provided the strength we need to steer clear of temptation. (1 Corinthians 10:13) You and I can say no to sin because the Spirit of Christ lives within us. The Holy Spirit is here to help us and lead us to all truth and knowledge. Stand as a child of God claiming His strength and victory. Be encouraged.

Please join us as we celebrate Black History this year. We have activities designed for all members of the congregation—youth to adults. Here's how you can participate:

**Black History Trivia Contest**—Questions will be placed in the bulletin each Sunday during the month of February. Prizes will be awarded. All are welcome to test your knowledge.

**Famous African Americans Past and Present**—Each Sunday during the morning worship service, **youth and young adults** of the church will select a noted African American and share information about that person with the congregation.

**Black History Wax Museum (all ages)**—Select an African American you wish to represent. Dress as that person and be prepared to present information about that person's life and accomplishments. You may be asked questions as well. You can use props if you like.

Suggestions for your presentation

Begin your presentation with a "hook" to capture the attention of your audience. Here are some sample statements you can use:

- I've always been interested in...*
- Imagine a world with/without...*
- A question*
- A quote from the famous American*
- An action such as a dance move, kicking a ball etc.*

- People will always remember me for...*
- My (ideas, novel, inventions) changed the world.*
- I am living in \_\_\_\_ today with my (husband, children, grandchildren)*
- I continue to fight for...*
- Without me the world...*

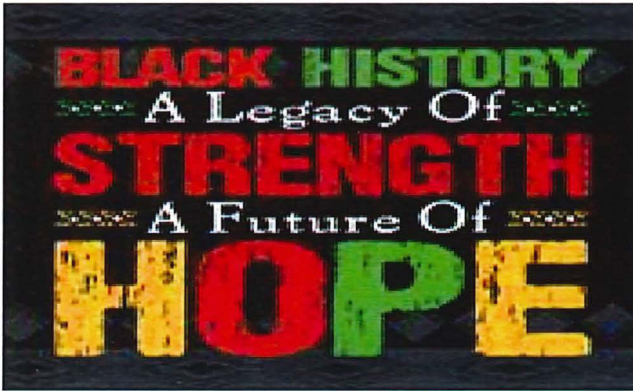
