# **Devotional**

Hiding from God:

The Lord asks Adam, "Where are you?" in Genesis 3:9. It was not a statement of ignorance about Adam's whereabouts but to bring out the truth of why he was hiding. He was hiding because of fear, shame, and guilt. But the question goes even further in its penetration; Adam had taken himself out of the will of God. But hiding did not keep him from the eyesight of the Lord. "The eyes of the Lord are everywhere keeping watch on the bad and the good." (Proverbs 15:3) Adam had been given specific instructions by God that would allow him to both live in harmony with the garden but also keep him in step with the will of God. God's creation of mankind was and is for His glory. That glory for God comes when we live our lives in a way that is consistent with His will. (John 17) Even when we pray He has instructed us to pray according to His will. (Matthew 6:10) In our day to day interactions, we are instructed to seek His will. (Matthew 6:33) Adam got in trouble when he removed himself from the will of God. You and I also get in trouble whenever we leave the will of God. So here is the question for you today: Where are you? Are you in His will? Stay focus on His word and way. Be in His will. Be encouraged.
