The Bent of your heart

Jesus Himself was a wonderful model of openness as He dealt with His disciples. On one occasion He modeled being a servant by washing the feet of His disciples. (John 13:5) While later in the Garden of Gethsemane, He shared with the disciples His anguish over His upcoming crucifixion and brief earthly life from God the Father. (Matthew 26:36) Knowing that the sins of the entire world were about to be cast upon Him, Jesus grieved, even to the point of near death. Here was God, clothed in human flesh, being completely honest, open, and forthright about His emotions. This is how Christ would have us react to Him. This was the bent of His heart. For many Christians today who are proud, egotistical, and self-sufficient, they would bristle at the thought of such transparency. We believe we can handle anything. We are going to do things our way. However, such thinking and behavior is against everything for which God created us. The Lord cherishes and honors a humble, contrite spirit from those who will serve Him. (Matthew 6-7) Confess your sin and shortcomings. Confess your willingness to be open and empty before Him. 
*********************************** Pursuant to Article XII (12) of the Bylaws of First Baptist
