## Devotional

### *Fulfill your ministry:*

My friend and brother Edward McCree, Pastor of the Israel Baptist Church in Detroit and I both spoke at a retirement celebration banquet of a mutual friend. McCree was the principal speaker who used 2 Timothy 4: 6-7 to emphasize that Rev. T. W. Jenkins was retiring as a pastor but not as a preacher. Jenkins had been a preacher and pastor for 40 years before a decline in his health. He was not physically able to pastor but he can still preach. Hence, Paul's message to Timothy was that he fulfill his ministry. (2 Timothy 4:1-5) In effect, there is a passing of the guard from pastor to supply preacher for Jenkins and Paul passing his leadership and evangelistic baton to Timothy. Although he was confined to a prison cell Paul never stopped allowing the Lord to use him. He told Timothy to let the Lord use him as well. In a similar way, no matter what stage of life you may be in, God can still use you. Retired? No problem. You have more time for the Lord. Little money? No problem. You can still share the Lord's word with others. Home and employment responsibilities have become overwhelming? No problem. You can still model the peace of God in a busy life. Health challenges? No problem. You can still model the grace of God before others. In all areas of life, you and I can represent the Lord in our lives. Again, Paul said, "fulfill your ministry." Be encouraged.
