



Devotional

Looking up during high winds:

Storms are inevitable. In nature, powerful tempests of high winds leave a changed landscape behind them. In our lives, challenging circumstances can force us to shift direction. When difficulties arise do not assume that being in the center of God's will exempts us from problems. In Matthew 14, we learn that Jesus instructed the disciples to get in the boat and go to the other side of the sea. While they were obeying Him, high winds and waves developed. The truth is, storms can arise even when we are exactly where God wants us to be. (John 16:33) Further, many of us automatically assume that we are a large part of the problem. God does use trials to correct us, but not all situations come from our mistakes. He may allow troubles to perfect us-that is, to mature us and grow us into Christ's likeness. That was the case with the disciples. Jesus knew what laid ahead for them, and He desired to make them fit vessels for the work He was calling them to do. The high winds created an environment conducive to learning key lessons for future ministry. God uses different ways to train and equips us because He wants us to become strong and vital servants. We must realize that nothing can happen to a child of God unless He allows it. The Lord has promised to never leave nor forsake us. (Hebrews 13:5) Instead of keeping our heads bent down during life struggles, let's look up to the Lord even during high winds. Be encouraged.
