
## Devotional: It could be you


It could be you:

When we think of all the people that Jesus could have appeared to first after His resurrection, no one may have thought of Mary Magdalene. The Jews of that day believe the testimony of a woman was not to be held in high regard. Some rabbis believe that the words of the law should be burned rather than to have them delivered at the hands of a woman. Yet the Lord chose a woman to be the first herald of His resurrection. It is worth noting that women were the last at the cross and the first at the tomb. (Luke 23-24) Mary had the courage that many of the men were lacking when Jesus was crucified. She stood by Him through it all. In fact, the bible tells us that after Jesus was crucified, that Mary "observed where He was laid." (Mark 15:47) She had watched as they took His crucified body from the cross and wrapped it and placed it in a tomb that belonged to Joseph of Arimathea. God said, "And you will seek Me and find Me when you search for Me with your heart." (Jeremiah 29:13) If you will take the time today to seek Him, to read His word, He will reveal His truths to you.
