Muhammad Ali was one of the most important mortal men to have lived on this earth. He took a stand for what he viewed as right and never wavered. He was criticized, ostracized, and called every name in the book. But he never wavered from his convictions. Yet we learned later after he lost several years of being able to box, earn a living, that his stand for righteousness was not just about himself. He became world famous through his boxing gift but also for the causes that he took up on behalf of others, He traveled the world on behalf of the poor and disenfranchised. Time proved him right. Time brought him favor from around the world. Although his convictions never changed, the world did change. That is it! In a similar way, our Lord Jesus Christ came so that the world might change and turn to the one true God. (John 6:38-40) He told us in John 9, that He was the "Light of the world" which means apart from Him we live in darkness. In John 10, He told us that He was the "Door" through which is the way to the Father of life.
