Seeking the good of others:

The story is told that in an old village in England, a certain inscription was found on a tombstone: "Here lies a miser who lived for himself and cared for nothing but gathering wealth. Now, where he is or how he fares, nobody knows and nobody cares." How would you like to have something like that written on your tombstone? A better epitaph would be for others to say of you, "This person was always thinking of and caring for others." Obviously, the latter statement speaks of a person who knew how to love other people. The Apostle Paul said, "love does not behave itself unseemly or rudely, seeketh not her own, is not easily provoked, thinketh no evil". (1 Corinthians 13:5) In other words, true love has good manners. This is something that is largely lost in our culture today. We take the attitude that if we offend someone that they will get over it. on the other side, if someone offends us we might decide to keep a record. But as a part of the body of Christ, we cannot easily discount the experiences of others. When we love someone we must love all of them. To love is to care. To care is to lend a helping hand. After all, the world does not revolve just around you or me. The Christian walk requires that we put the interest of others first. The Christian walk requires that we practice the love of God. God's love is not provoked. It is not aroused to anger or evil, nor does it keep a record of wrongdoings. No God's love means we seek the good of our brothers and sisters at all times. (Galatians 6:1-5) Be encouraged.
