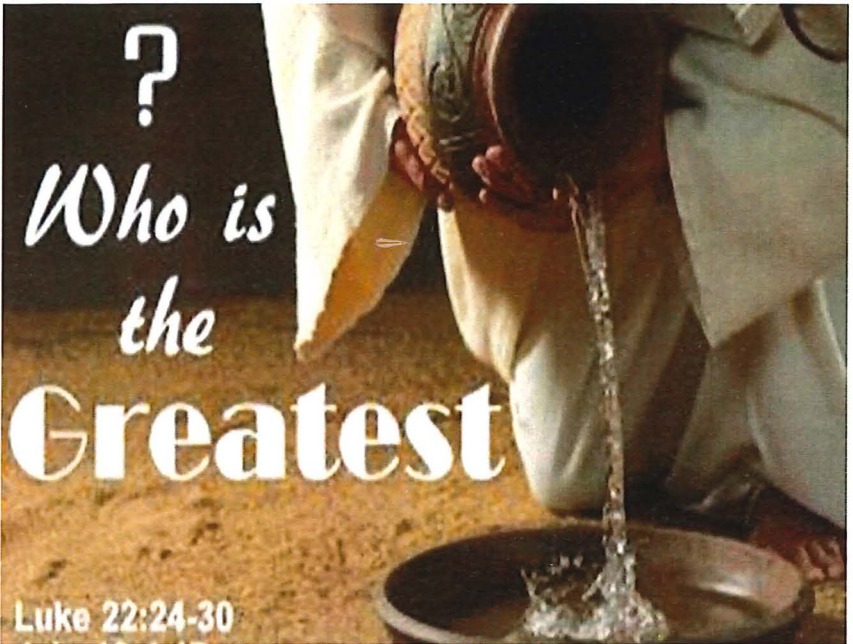

Devotional:

The diligent shall find Him:

It is clear that God rewards the diligent. Our Lord Jesus Christ could have appeared to many individuals after His resurrection, but He appeared firstly to Mary Magdalene. It is interesting to think about, because among the Jews of the day, the testimony of a woman was not held in high regard. In fact, some Rabbis falsely taught that it was better for the words of the Law to be burned than to be delivered by a woman. Yet Jesus chose a woman to be the first herald of His resurrection. It is also worth noting that women were the last at the cross and first at the tomb. Mary had the courage that the men did not have when Jesus was crucified. She stood by Him through it all. In fact, the Bible tells us that after Jesus was crucified, Mary "observed where He was laid". (Mark 15:47) She watched as they took His crucified body from the cross and wrapped it and place it in a tomb that belongs to Joseph of Arimathea. God said, "And you will seek Me and find Me when you search for me with all your heart". (Jeremiah 29:13) The Lord rewards the person who is diligent. And for those who will take time in their day to seek the Lord, for those who will take the time to read His Word, for those who will take the time to wait upon Him, He will reveal His truths to them.
