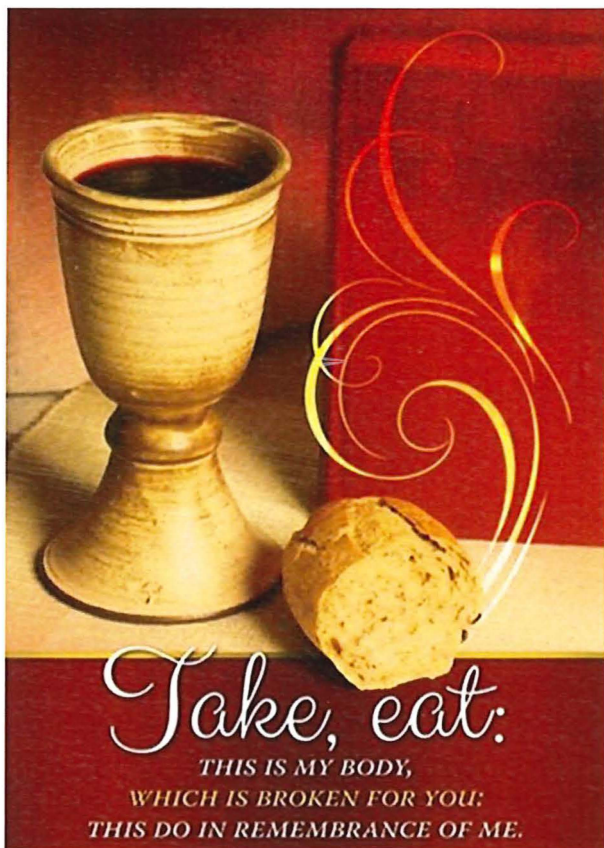

Devotional

To Be In Christ:

The word "orthodoxy" comes from two little Greek words that together mean, "having the right opinion." Typically it is used to express the intellectual adherence to the well-researched accepted norms of faith. It is in many ways a common understanding of Scripture that has stood the test of time. In addition, it serves as a defense against heresy. In Matthew 23:23-24, our Lord scorned the Pharisees for their concentration on the forms of faith but not the life of faith. Today the similarity would be the Christian who regularly criticizes those who they disagree with politically but never come to the table of faith with them spiritually. Orthodoxy then becomes isolation. That isolation leads to what Jeff Christopherson refers to as "a lifeless debate among sterilized and unproductive leaders." Hint: Orthodoxy that has fallen into seclusion is dangerous. What we have seen in many churches currently is that isolation has led to their decline and in some cases their death as a congregation. Why? Jesus Christ intends for the church to be a beacon light of the reality of heaven to a lost world. (Matthew 5:14-16) We cannot just tell people about the church, we must be the church in the world. The church must be unified in Christ and in His word. "Where two or three are gathered together in my name" is the promise of His presence. (Matthew 18:20) The promise of heaven is for those who are in Christ. Be encouraged.
