Devotional:

What would He have you to do?

In Acts 9:6 the Apostle Paul, Saul at the time, asked the Lord what would He have him to do. Interestingly, Paul, when the Lord identified Himself asked the above question. He started the journey on the Damascus Road to arrest and punish anyone associated with Jesus. But along the way he meets Jesus for himself. The encounter was so powerful that Paul fell to the ground in reverence to the Lord. He moved from hate to humility. He moved from gathering folks for imprisonment to gathering folks for Jesus. He moved from seeking a high position within the Jewish Sanhedrin Council to seeking a servant's position in the army of the Lord. Paul's question is one that has escaped the motives of Christian service. Christian service is all about putting others first. Jesus said in Matthew 20:28, that He did not come for man to minister to Him but that He came to give His life as a ransom for mankind. When preachers focus on airplanes, fancy cars, clothes, gated homes, and anniversaries, it's all about him or her. When a layperson focuses on a position, certain seat, having their name called, it's all about him or her. When public figures focus on gifts and favors rather than service, it's all about him or her. Jesus was never about Himself but the will of His Father. (John 6) What is your life all about? Yourself? Others? Career? Material possessions? Paul's life became about what the Lord wanted him to do. (Philippians 3) Unless your life is about seeking the will of God nothing else matters became it will not last. Build your hope on things eternal. Be encouraged. 
