



#### **Devotional**

Good job:

In Baton Rouge, Louisiana, former Southern University pitcher Daniel Franklin stepped to the mound against Arkansas-Pine Bluff one Saturday. He took a deep breath and looked to the section of stands closest to the Jaguars dugout. To most people, the spot was empty. To Franklin, his father was right where he had been for every game since his son was in Little League. Terry Franklin had died of complications that stemmed from high cholesterol. For the first time since Daniel can remember, his father wasn't at one of his son's games. Daniel thinks his dad really would have liked what he saw in the way that he was pitching. Franklin believes his father would've said, "Good job, baby boy. Good job." Daniel added, "He would've called me by my nickname, 'D-Frank.'" The goal of every child of God, is to worship and work in God's ministry in a way that is pleasing to Him. The Lord's command was to deny yourself, take up your cross daily, and follow Him wherever He desires for your life and for my life. (Luke 9:23). But more than anything, it is the goal of every child of God to be listening to hear Him say, "Well done" which sounds like "Good job". (Matthew 25:21-23) Be encouraged.
