On her bucket list of things to do in life was to run the world famous Great North Run which is a half marathon. With the aid of a robotic exoskeleton suit, she trained for the run while 16 weeks pregnant and battling morning sickness and her paralyzation. However, with the help of her husband and sheer determination, she finished the 13.1-mile course in 5 days. What kept her going? Her daughter and having a chance to go into a school and help just one other person. Hebrews 12:1,2 speak of the joy and sheer determination of our Lord Jesus Christ while on the cross of Calvary. 2 Corinthians 3,4 speak of the sheer determination of Paul to never give up in carrying the gospel to the world. 
