### **Devotional**

The imminent day to come:

Several friends of mine have recently lost a mother or a father. They had been told that their mother's or father's death was imminent. Yet, like many of us that type of pronouncement never really registers in the reality of our minds. We were also told in the Word of God that man has an appointment with death because of Adam's sin. (Genesis 3:19) But unless you are an older human being, you do not really think about death. It is like a picture on the wall. You know it is there but you rarely look at it. David described death as being a shadow. (Psalm 23:4) Note the irony of scripture: Jesus told a group of individuals, "I came that you might have life and life more abundantly." (John 10:10) Those individuals were alive on the earth. Yet Jesus implied that they did not have a life. What gives? The life before Jesus had come is temporary. The life Jesus brings is eternal. To receive the eternal life offered by Jesus requires a transition. That transition is called death. Jesus describes it as being asleep. Then John says we shall wake up to the eternal bliss of heaven in His presence. (Revelation 21) Think about it. Everyone who dies in the Lord has life eternal. That is what we should want for a loved one. For on that day we shall meet again. Be encouraged. (Source:raycampbellblog.wordpress.com)
