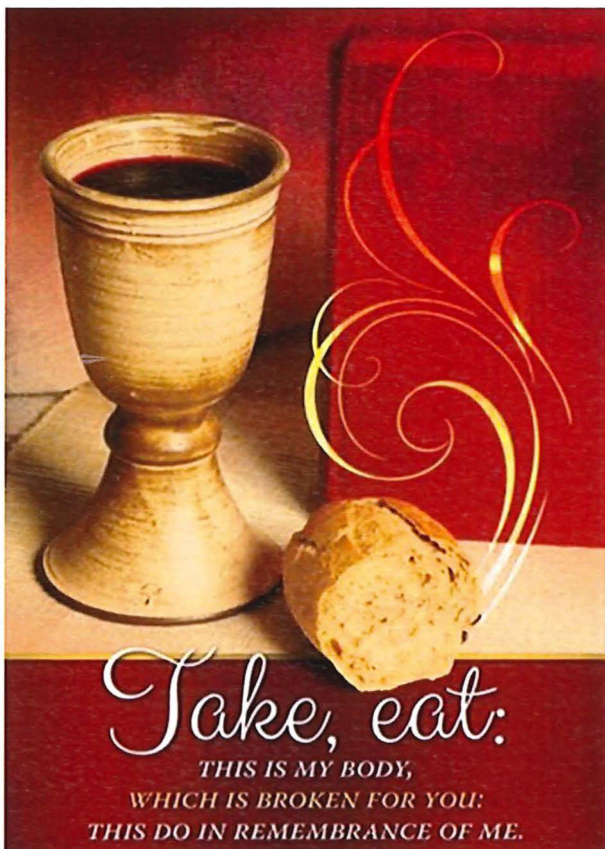

In Karen Kingsbury's best seller "The Chance", she tells the story of a young and broken girl named Ellie Tucker, navigating the travails of a broken home, losing a boyfriend, becoming pregnant, and then finding a friend that was always there for her, Nolan Cook. Nolan not only accepted her, the baggage of her past but more importantly, her newly born baby. In the end, it was a fairy tale ending. Life is not always about a happy ending. Sometimes your mistakes in life are never very far behind you. Pregnancies, drug addictions, hanging with the wrong crowds, school failures, are all stop gaps on the way to success. The problem is that too often individuals in these situations do not find the right friend or the right intervention specialist. Saul had one in Samuel but he did not take advantage. (2 Samuel 15) David had one in Nathan and did take advantage. (2 Samuel 7) Occasionally on Facebook, many of you take inventory of your friends. As the Liberty Mutual TV commercial would say, "That's smart!" What would be even smarter is for you and I to make Jesus our number one friend. Then surround yourself with other friends of Jesus. Because friends of Jesus stick with you all the way. (Galatians 6) Be encouraged.

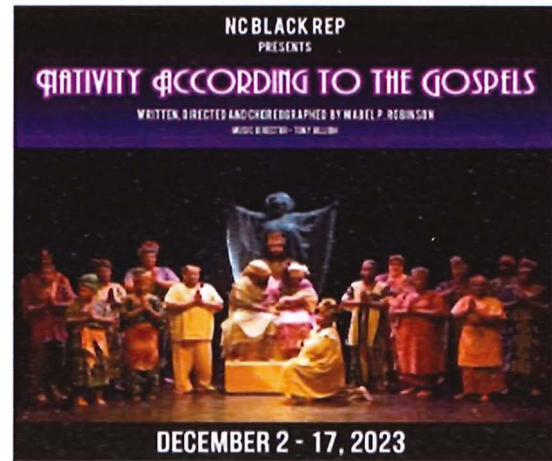
SALVATION ARMY TOY DRIVE
