Every so often I find myself re-reading something in the bible that I have read many times over. But as I have prayed while reading, the Holy Spirit does what He does, gives continuous inspiration. For example, how many times I have read Peter walking on the water with Jesus in Matthew 14? Many times. Yet forever and a day, I missed one word in that text over and over again.
