Devotional

Remember who you are:

The Apostle Paul gamely pursued the timid Timothy as his successor in ministry. His second epistle, also entitled Timothy, is full of words to inspire, encourage, and to motivate him. He reminds Timothy of his Christian background and the influence of his grandmother and mother. (1:5) Added to that influence is that Timothy had Paul as his personal tutor. So Paul tells Timothy in chapter 1 to "fan the flame" and/or "use the gift" of ministry given to him by the Holy Spirit. (vs. 6) Then there are 2 words Timothy had to confront from Paul: (1) You can't be ashamed to be a Christian; (vs.1-6) and (2) Know that on the way to your reward you will "suffer."(vs.12) Our Lord has promised all of us that we will face trouble (John 16) in life, but He would be with us every step of the way (Matthew 28). The flooding waters of life have wrecked havoc in the lives of some. Lost possessions have been a source of discouragement to others. Further, financial losses and material upheaval colored the future even more. But be glad "that trouble doesn't last always." Remember who you are always. Be encouraged.
