Scholarship applications are available in the narthex, and on the table across from the main office. The deadline to turn in applications in the church office is Friday, May 17.

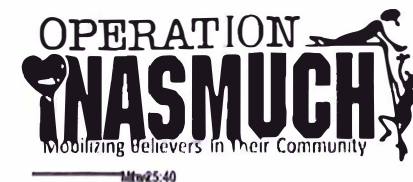
