 matriculation at a chosen college or university.
- · Payments will be made directly to the institution, once enrollment is CERTIFIED by the institution's registrar.
- Amounts will be paid by semester, ½ in August and the second ½ in January (excluding summer sessions).
- EACH STUDENT MUST PROVIDE AN UPDATED TRANSCRIPT AT THE END OF EACH SEMESTER.
