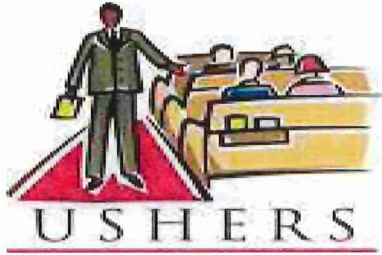
The Women’s Service Council will meet November 16th after the Sunday worship service in the J.C. White Lounge. New members are welcome.
