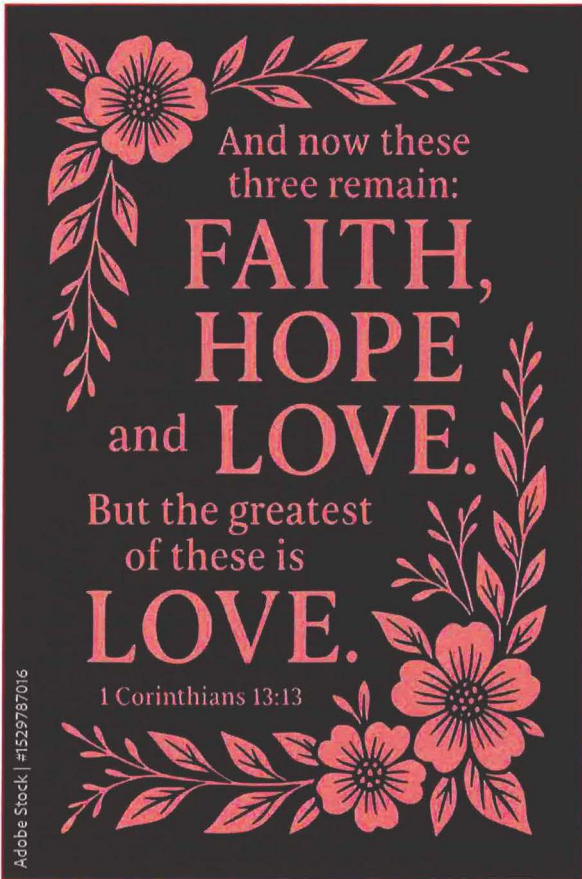

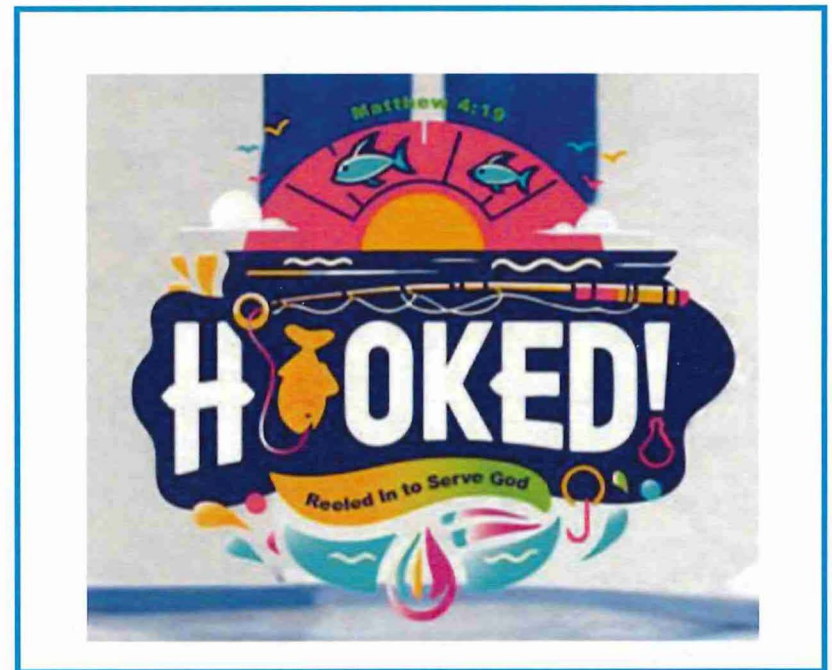
VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL
