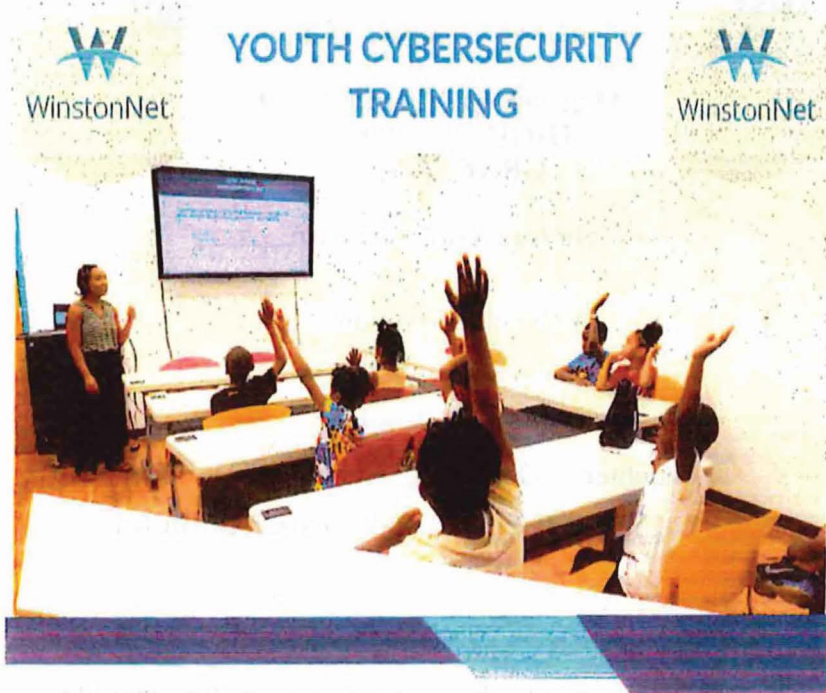

Youth are trained to recognize suspicious activity, such as phishing, scams, and unsafe websites, which gives them the confidence to make smart decisions online.
