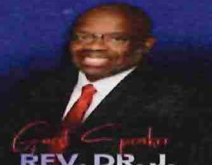
Caring for Our Skin This Summer

This 1-hour interactive session equips youth with the essential skills to safely navigate the internet and protect themselves in today's digital world. Participants learn practical cybersecurity habits, including safeguarding personal information, creating strong passwords, and avoiding online risks.

The class also builds awareness of how data is collected and used, helping students understand their digital footprint and manage their online presence responsibly. Youth are trained to recognize suspicious activity, such as phishing, scams, and unsafe websites, which gives them the confidence to make smart decisions online.

By the end of the session, participants are not only more informed but also empowered to share cybersecurity knowledge with their friends and family, becoming digital safety leaders in their communities.
