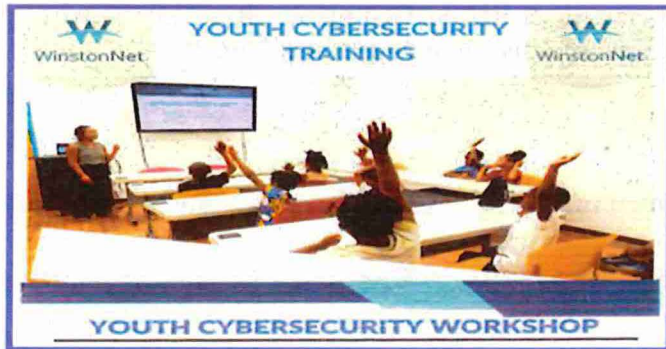
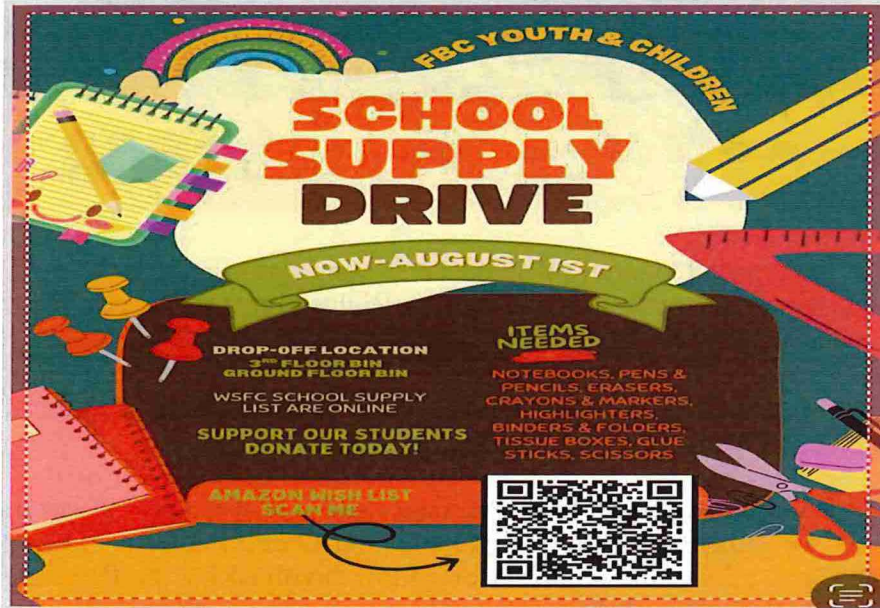
Grace and Peace!!
