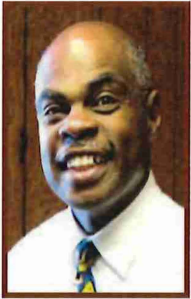

Acknowledging a call to the ministry while a high school student in Durham, NC, Rev. Pettiford began preparing for the ministry as a member of Mt. Gilead Baptist Church in Durham. He was licensed in 1970 and ordained in 1976. The wise and gracious Rev. Alexander D. Mosely was his Pastor and Father in the ministry.

Glenn is a graduate of the Lincoln University (Pa.). He completed seminary work at Virginia Union University School of Theology in Richmond, Virginia; Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary in Wake Forest NC.; and the Interdenominational Theological Center in Atlanta, Ga.

Presently, Glenn is the Assistant Pastor at First Baptist Church on Highland Avenue in Winston-Salem, NC. Previously, he served as Pastor for 17 years at the First Baptist Church (Village Drive), Lexington, NC. Before pastoring, he was a prison and jail Chaplain with the Prison Ministry (then, Forsyth Prison Chaplaincy).

Glenn is the eldest of four living children of Mac and Jettlean Pettiford and the nephew of two aunts. He is proud to be the uncle of about twenty nephews and nieces, and the cousin of a host of cousins. There is still a great love for life in the county, where he lived for his first six years with his grandparents. During Christmas vacation at the age of 10, he was converted to faith by Grandmama's testimony. Granddaddy said, "Son, the best thing you can get in life is wisdom and understanding."
