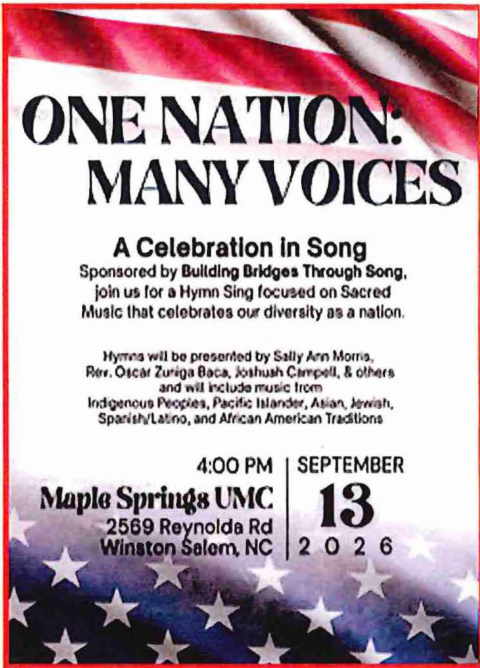
Clothes Closet - The clothes closet is **ONLY** accepting children's clothes. No adult clothes are needed at this time. Thank you.

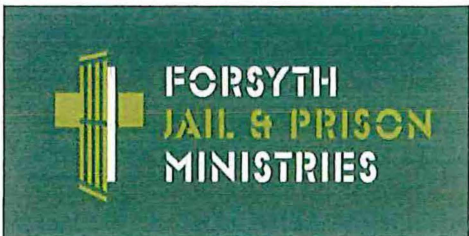
